With the school year coming to a close it's time to talk summer! This article contains info for both Jr. and Sr. High ministries.



**Cemetery News** 

With summer upon us, it is important to be reminded of some of the Rules & Regulations of Trinity's Cemetery:

- ANY burials or spreading of ashes in Trinity's Cemetery are prohibited without pre-approval from the Cemetery Board. Both state and cemetery regulations need to be adhered to.
- Flowers and plants should be placed in rugged, • sturdy containers which can be placed on either side of the monuments. They should not be planted directly in the ground. NO glass containers are allowed in the cemetery.
- In-ground plantings (trees, shrubs, etc.) are subject ٠ to Cemetery Board approval. Approval must be given prior to anything being planted.
